Installation on Linux

To install UGENE on Linux:

• Download UGENE Linux installation package:



Installers:

- Download 32-bit <u>Universal</u> installer
- Download 64-bit Universal installer

Universal binary packages:

- · Download 32-bit Standard or Full package
- · Download 64-bit Standard or Full package
- · Download 64-bit NGS package
- Set the file as executable:

chmod +x [name of the downloaded file]

• Launch the file and follow the Unipro Setup wizard.



Alternatively, to use UGENE without installing:



Installers:

- Download 32-bit Universal installer
- · Download 64-bit Universal installer

Universal binary packages:

- Download 32-bit Standard or Full package
- · Download 64-bit Standard or Full package
- Download 64-bit NGS package
- Unpack the archive. You can use this command:

```
tar -xf [name of the downloaded *.tar.gz file]
```

• Change the working directory to the unpacked UGENE directory:

cd [name of the unpacked directory]

• Launch the UGENE GUI version using the command:

./ugene -ui

or the command line version using the command:

./ugene



Several native packages for specic Linux distributions are also available. UGENE is a part of Ubuntu and Fedora Linux distributions. See the next chapter.
